COMMUNION: A CELEBRATION OF REMEMBRANCE

Communion is a reminder of our salvation through faith in Jesus Christ. At CCSM, we believe that through His death on the cross and resurrection, Jesus redeemed us and gives us eternal life.

As we share communion, we think about His body, broken for us (the bread); and His blood, poured out for us (the cup). The bread and cup remind us of the price He paid to save us, and this leads us to humble, thankful, joyful worship. Jesus said, "Do this in remembrance of Me," (Lk 22:19), and as we do, we proclaim His death, resurrection and one day, His return.

Like the early church, we share communion often (1 Cor 11:23-26). And we invite you to join us, if you profess that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead. Please take the bread and cup, then hold them and we will all partake together. If you have not yet declared your faith in Jesus, please allow the bread and cup to pass.
